### NOVICE CLASSES NOT OFFERED

---

#### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

#### GRAND CHAMPION

Champions of Record and dogs which have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed that are entered in Best of Breed competition are eligible for Grand Championship competition. Grand Championship points may be recorded for: Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Best of Variety of Breed, Select Dog, and Select Bitch. Grand Championship points will be recorded according to the number of eligible dogs competing in the regular and non-regular (eligible for Best of Breed/Variety) classes of each breed or variety, as well as dogs competing in Best of Breed competition, according to the Schedule of Points established by the Board of Directors. (*AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 16, Section 6, effective 11-01-2017*)

#### AWARDS OF MERIT

The specialty judge may at his/her discretion award Judge's Awards of Merit to a maximum of THREE awards from the Best of Breed entry, plus Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, along with the Winners of the Veteran, Field Trial, and Hunting Classes. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch and Best of Winners awards are made. All dogs remaining in competition, including Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, are eligible for an Award of Merit.

#### AMATEUR OWNER HANDLER CLASS ELIGIBILITY

For non-champion dogs at least 6 months of age. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. Entry is limited to exhibitors who have never been a professional handler, an AKC-approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the AKC Dog Show Rules). *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributes rule cards, or otherwise advertise or represent themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

#### BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class.

#### BEST PUPPY CLASS ELIGIBILITY - #2 (PM) ONLY

Best Puppy will be selected from the Puppy Class winners (6-9, 9-12) following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Puppy Class are eligible to compete.

#### BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY - #2 (PM) ONLY

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Bred-by-Exhibitor Class are eligible to compete.

#### BEST VETERAN CLASS ELIGIBILITY - #2 (PM) ONLY

Best Veteran will be selected from the Veteran Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in a Veteran Class are eligible to compete.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

**NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.**

\*Veteran Dog Class      \*Veteran Bitch Class

*A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are 7 years of age or older.*

**\*Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."**

#### **Field Trial Dog and Field Trial Bitch**

Class for dogs and class for bitches who have a placement or a Judge's Award of Merit for an AKC licensed field trial. Only winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed competition. Exhibitor please have proof of the FT placement or JAOM with you on the day of the show.

#### **Hunting Dog and Hunting Bitch**

Class for dogs and class for bitches who have an AKC hunting title of JH, SH or MH. Only winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed.

## **SWEEPSTAKES: Friday AM**

Sweepstakes is open to all Vizsla dogs and bitches 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. There is a \$22.00 entry fee per dog. The Sweepstakes Class must be specified in the "Additional Class" space on the entry form. Thirty percent of the entry fee is retained by the Vizsla Club of the Northern California to defray expenses. Seventy percent is allocated toward cash prizes. Each dog or bitch must be entered in one of the regular classes at this show.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Sweepstakes Classes. The Veteran Sweepstakes Class must be specified in the "Additional Class" space on the entry form. Thirty percent of the entry fee is retained by Vizsla Club of the Northern California to defray expenses. Seventy percent is allocated toward cash prizes.

## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION (PM Only)**

**Novice.** Novice. This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open.** Open. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master.** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE. EACH DOG ENTERED MUST BE OF THE BREED FOR WHICH THIS SHOW IS HELD.**

Junior Handlers must put their Junior Handler's number on the entry blank. To obtain a Junior Handler number, call the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776 or E-mail at juniors@akc.org.

**Notice:** *Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. By signing the entry form, certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.*

**Best Junior Handler:** The Vizsla Club of Northern California offers a prize for Best Junior Handler. The Junior Handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, Doris Bandoian, 1220 N. Richfield Rd., Anaheim, CA 92807-1812, by 12:00 PM-NOON, PT, Wednesday, May 02, 2018. Fees should accompany entries. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
  2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The CLUB will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
  3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary. Confirmations returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" will be held at the Show Secretary's office. **PLEASE BRING YOUR CONFIRMATIONS TO THE SHOW.**
  4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owner of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, it's owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of these clubs nor the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 6 AM to 8 PM.
  5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring by completion of the breed and the show secretaries office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
  6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the premium list. Rule books may be obtained from A.K.C., online at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org).
  7. The Club, the Show Secretary or the members or employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor/owner or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler/agent during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
  8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done at least 20 ft. away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
  9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fees for duplicate entry.
  10. Only dogs that are eligible to compete to be allowed on the grounds.
  11. The Vizsla Club of Northern California., may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
  12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
  13. **Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.**
  14. A recording fee of 50 cents per dog and an event service fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)
  15. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Confirmation judging at the show.
  16. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show after the closing of entries for a show are **required to transfer** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Event Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier..
